
Make a Moon Phase Mobile

MATERIALS


- 2 x sheets gold or silver A4 card
- Moon shape templates
- Scissors
- · Glue (PVA/craft) and something to apply it with
- Approx 2 metres thin ribbon
- · Pencil or a pen







Cut out the sheet of moon shapes and draw round them on your gold/silver card. If only one side is metallic, draw the shapes on the non-shiny side. Draw each shape twice, you will need two sets of shapes. You should end up with 2 x full moon shapes and 4 x the other three moon shapes.



On a length of ribbon, you can start arranging your shapes as shown in the diagram. Find your matching shapes and use one for the front and one for the back, glueing them together with the ribbon in between and the gold/silver on the outside.





Tie a small loop for the top (and bottom too if you wish) for hanging. Your garland can be hung vertically or horizontally as a seasonal decoration.
